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ITINERARY

Throughout your stay, Liz McCoy will be there to guide and assist you with each day's activities or any inquiries or request that you have.

We have planned the week to give you a taste of life on Norfolk Island in the past as well as in the present, while still giving you time to relax and enjoy Norfolk Island at your own pace.

DAY ONE – THURSDAY

Your day will commence with check-in at the Brisbane International Airport. You need to check-in 90 minutes before departure.

Your private charter flight will depart at 10.00am for Norfolk Island, arriving at 1.35pm.

If you're thinking about pre-flight shopping, snacks or coffee, make sure you do it in the main departure's hall. Flights to Norfolk Island often leave from gate 74 which is at the far end of one of the departure arms and there are no concession stores near the gate.



Your flight to Norfolk will include lunch. On arriving in Norfolk Island, you will be entering the arrivals hall where you will have to collect your bag and then clear immigration and quarantine.

Once you have cleared immigration and quarantine, take a left turn when you exit the arrivals hall and a Norfolk Island Tourism representative will be there to greet you and let them know you are staying at Seaview and they will point you in the right direction to the Pinetree tours who transfer you to Seaview.

When you arrive, we will have you pre-checked in and it is simply a matter to unpack, unwind and enjoy the view. Either relax in your room or the lounge or stretch your legs and take a walk into town.

DINNER - After returning to Seaview to rest, get ready for tonight's cliff top dinner.

The Island Fish Fry is the most popular event for visitors to Norfolk Island. It has been operating for our 40 years. As well as enjoying local fish you will taste some of the popular Island dishes, with local entertainment with the Baunti Byuutis dancing group on our exclusive Western Side property 'Orn Daa Cliff'. For those who self-drive and would like to stay for a short time, you can view the incredible sun setting over the ocean.

Your guided tour will include, the gracious original Bailey homestead & gardens, a stroll through the barn, dairy and out-buildings, a museum filled with items of nostalgic and historic interest, the oldest working forge in the Pacific, an ex New Zealand Army hut, with war-time memorabilia, an exclusive film of Norfolk Island interest and complimentary refreshments

DINNER - Your welcome dinner tonight will be in our Seaview's Mariah's lounge, hosted by Liz who you would have already met when you check-in.

Dinner is a three-course casual dining affair with a commentary from Liz about the week to come and about contemporary Norfolk Island living.



DAY 3 - SUNDAY

LUNCH – today's lunch is at the Olive Branch located at the Norfolk Island Golf Club.





After lunch Liz will take you through the area and explain how the area has evolved into the living museum it is today, being the main hub for all settlements from pre-European days, the harsh convict times to the arrival of the Pitcairn family's.

Liz will show you the hidden gems that go unseen by the unknowing passer-by, as well as a comprehensive visit to the cemetery where some of the oldest know European memorials blend in with executed convicts, murdered military, Children of the Bounty Mutineers and modern day burial practices all in the one burial ground still in use today.

DINNER - On the progressive dinner you will join a group of Norfolk Island visitors and be taken to carefully selected island homes where you will hear Norfolk stories from your dinner hosts.


The Progressive Dinner is a fun night and a great way to meet the local people

After breakfast the morning is yours to do with as you wish, either relax in at sea view and soak up the view, or head out for some self-exploration.


Maybe take in some tours of your own choice like the popular Colleen McCullough tour (optional)

Your museum pass allows you to explore the various museums located in the Kingston historical area. Starting with the Pier Store. From there we recommend you take a leisurely stroll around Kingston and visit the various museums, or if you prefer, we will be running a hop on and hop off shuttle during museum tour



DINNER – Before dinner you are invited on a private tour of the RSL Memorial Clubs museum. We are very proud of the service given by Norfolk Islanders which was the highest per capita in the world.

Following the tour lunch will be in the RSL club bistro.

DAY 5 - WEDNESDAY

BREAKFAST – Wednesday breakfast starts with a choice of a 1.5km stroll through Palm Glen Reserve or for the more energetic, a leisurely 3.5km walk through scenic Mt. Bates to Captain Cook Monument. At the end of the walks we meet on the clifftop for a delicious breakfast barbecue. (These walks are not recommended to anyone with medical conditions).



If you prefer not to rise early and bush walk, but would like to have breakfast on the cliff top, join the walkers at Anson Bay & share in the delicious barbecue breakfast

After the breakfast bush walk, your next destination is the Norfolk Island Botanic Garden.



The Discovery Centre brings the outdoors indoors. An elegant wooden walkway leads to a rooftop viewing area where you'll get a fantastic view of Norfolk's vibrant green landscape including the iconic Norfolk Island pines.

There are fabulous ceramic sculptures of some of our special creatures, we're particularly fond of the giant centipede eating the gecko!

There is also a live video feed from Phillip Island, so you can check out what the weather is doing over there. The live feed showcases some breeding Masked Boobies and provides great views back to Norfolk.



Either before or after viewing the cyclorama, we suggest a casual stroll through Gallery Guava

The delightful art gallery, Gallery Guava, is located at the Cyclorama complex and displays a variety of works by Norfolk's leading artists.

Your tour includes a stroll through Fletcher's Mutiny Cyclorama, this amazing 360° painting offers a unique way to experience the history of the Bounty adventures and discover how the world's most famous mutiny created the Pitcairn and Norfolk Island communities.



LUNCH - Fridays lunch and tour is at Norfolk Island's Hilli Goat Farm where you will meet the Cheeky Goats and wander through the Edible Gardens whilst learning about the milking and cheese making process. Then sit down to a delicious Hilli Goat style



Platter of freshly made Goats Cheese and edible delights that have been freshly picked from our back yard and you've experienced the Paddock to Plate way of life or 'The Norfolk Way'.
